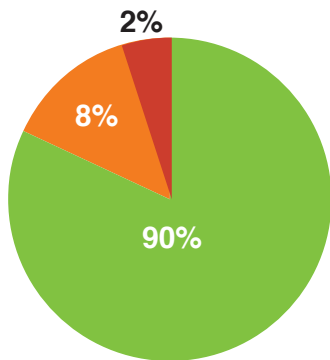

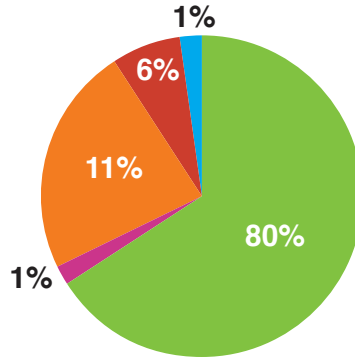

Gender

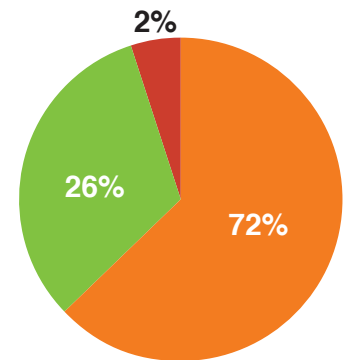
