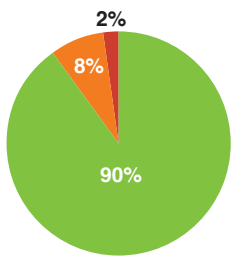

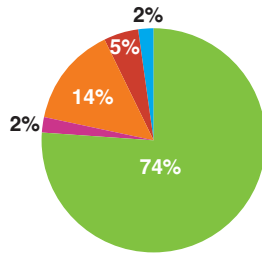

**Gender**

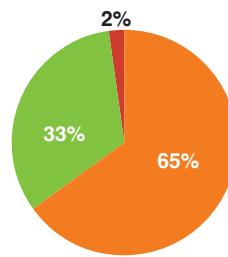

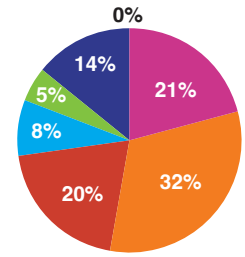
