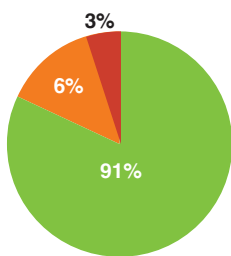

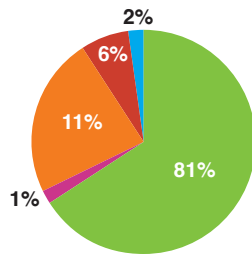

**Gender**

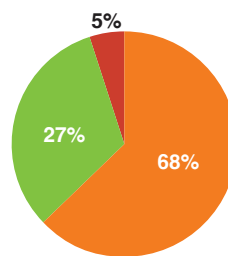

**Race**

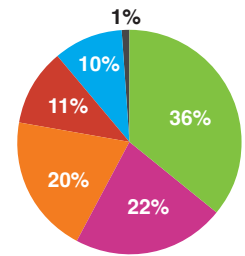
