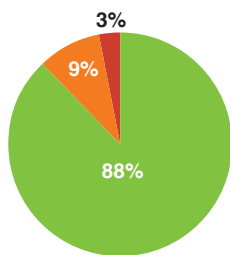

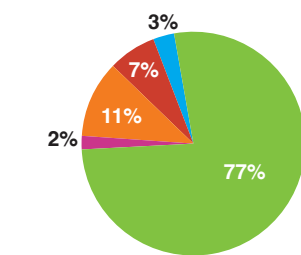

Gender

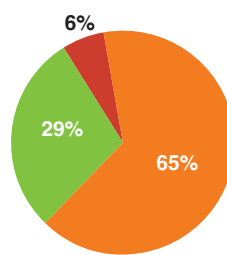

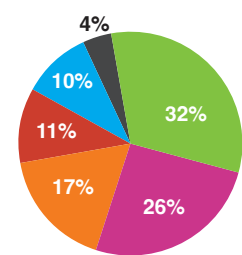
