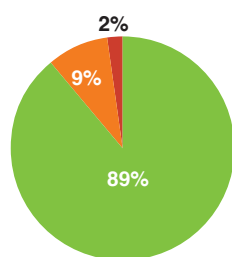
Since 2015 ACE Women's Business Center has been an economic development program that supports all small businesses, with a specific focus on empowering women through financial education and training.

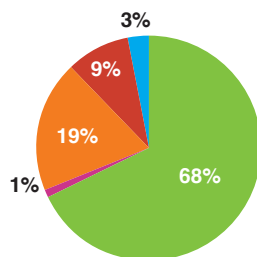

Gender

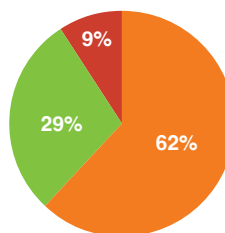

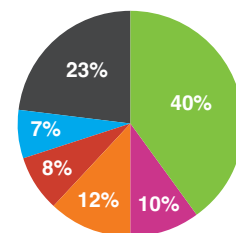
